Interviews Conducted: $\mathrm{N}=1,018$ registered voters (651 landline, 367 cell phone)

June 21-23, 2014

Questions 1, 4-9, 12, 22-27, and 29-40 are for release 6PM ET Tuesday, June 24, 2014. Questions 2-3, 10-11, 13-21, 28 and 41-42 are held for future release.

## Methodology

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Anderson Robbins Research (D) and Shaw \& Company Research (R). The poll was conducted by telephone with live interviewers June 21-23, 2014 among a random national sample of 1,018 registered voters (RV). Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus three percentage points.

Landline and cell phone telephone numbers were randomly selected for inclusion in the survey using a probability proportionate to size method, which means that phone numbers for each state are proportional to the number of voters in each state.

Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted.
